
Homework

Ideally children should read daily but the minimum expectation is 10 minutes 3 times a week. Books can usually be changed every day that the children return them. Any paper homework that goes out will go out on a Thursday and is to be returned by the following Tuesday.

English

This term we will be looking at the story of the Three little pigs. We will be focusing mainly on the settings within the story. We will be looking at a range of different setting used in other stories the children are familiar with.

We then want the children to have a go at writing their own setting story.



Please continue to read at home as this really helps children to become great writers! This can be their school book or any other books you have in the home.

Useful Vocabulary

Capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, adjectives, time conjunctions, setting,

Science

This term will be focusing on animals including humans. We will look at what animals need to survive. We will also look at life cycles of animals and humans.

RE

We will be learning about God, nature and creation across four different religions. Our focus will be celebrations throughout the year such as Eid, Diwali and Christmas.

Music

We will be learning about tempo. We will listen to a range of music at different speeds. We will then create our own music based on this.

PSHE

This will focus on exploring different strengths and abilities and understanding and challenging stereotypes.

Computing

Our computing lessons will focus on the importance of IT in the world and how we now use it everyday.

<u>Maths</u>

This term, we will continue to look at calculation in the form of multiplication and division.

Activities that will help at home:

- Get your child to practice counting forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and
 10s
- Play Maths games on top marks maths!
- Continue to practice number bonds to 10 and 20 (numbers that add together to make 10 or 20).
